**Goal:** School-based teams will identify a problem of practice, draw on relevant research to consider strengths and goals for improvement, and design an action research plan.

**Action Research Support:** The MLRC provides ongoing support for school-based teams through Online tools and resources available through the MLRC member Hub. Additionally, following the completion of each Research Symposium, the MLRC supports cohorts in the following ways:

February, March, April	<ul> <li>Monthly Webinars:         <ul> <li>Synchronous Zoom webinars focus on key topics to support team's ongoing action research projects, such as addressing common barriers, data collection and data analysis.</li> <li>All webinars are recorded to allow for asynchronous engagement if teams are unable to attend the live sessions.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
May	<ul> <li>Capstone Report:         <ul> <li>At the end of the school year, teams are invited to share their findings through a Capstone report, published in the MLRC School Network Member Hub.</li> <li>The goal is for all teams to share what they learned, how their findings can impact their school and possible next steps.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
On-Going	<ul> <li>Action Research Coaching (Optional):</li> <li>Action research coaches are an optional additional service to support teams through mentoring and guidance.</li> <li>If a school wants additional, customized and in-depth support, the MLRC has partnered with several consultants who can be contracted for action research coaching.</li> </ul>
On-Going	<ul> <li>Co-Writing &amp; Co-Presenting:         <ul> <li>Teams are encouraged to consider writing articles and/or presenting at regional conferences to share findings from their action research as well as lessons learned.</li> <li>Teams who complete a Capstone report may be offered the opportunity to co-write articles and/or co-present at conferences with the MLRC team.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
